STATEMENTS FOR MATERIALS

To be used by CME Accredited Providers

Accreditation Statement

When to Use: This statement must be included on any literature intended for learners (brochures, agendas, evaluation forms, certificates) except for "save-the-date" announcements.

Statement:

The (name of accredited provider) is accredited by the Maine Medical Association's Committee on Continuing Medical Education and Accreditation to provide Continuing Medical Education (CME) to physicians.

Designation Statement

When to Use: When informing learners about the CME credits an activity offers (brochures, agendas). Must be included on the CME Certificate. The statement should only be used after an activity is approved for CME.

Note: This statement must be in a separate paragraph from the accreditation statement. They should not be combined.

Statement:

The (name of accredited provider) designates this (type of activity) for a maximum of ___ AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)TM. Physicians should only claim credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

Joint Providership Statement

Who Uses It: Any organizations that are <u>not accredited</u> and are providing CME activities that are approved through an accredited provider need to include this statement on any literature intended for learners (brochures, agendas, evaluation forms, certificates).

Statement:

This activity has been planned and implemented in accordance with the accreditation requirements and policies of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME) through the joint providership of the (name of accredited provider) and (name of nonaccredited provider). The (name of accredited provider) is accredited by the Maine Medical Association Committee on Continuing Medical Education and Accreditation to provide continuing medical education for physicians.
